

1. Go to <u>https://texashighways.com/submitads</u>

- Select the link on the page that corresponds to the property for which you are uploading materials (website, E-Newsletter, etc.).
- 3. Select the file(s) you would like to upload from your computer.
- Fill out the "Client name, issue date, URL" field.
- 5. Enter your email address.
- 6. Click 'Submit' for file to upload.
- 7. <u>Remain on the page</u> until upload is complete and you see "Success! Your file has been submitted."
